Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutoring Program

Waiver, Release of Liability, Indemnification and Consent to Medical Attention

In exchange for my being allowed to participate in the **Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutoring Program** (the "Program"), a program administered by Village Tutors, I, and my parent or legal guardian (individually and collectively referred to below in the first person singular) agree to be bound by each of the following:

1. Voluntary Participation. I understand and confirm that my participation in the Program is voluntary.
2. Identification of Risks. I understand that my participation in the Program may involve risk of injury and loss, both to person and to property. I also understand that the risk of injury may include the possibility of permanent disability and death. I understand that this Waiver and Release of Liability is intended to address all of the risks of any kind associated with my participation in any aspect of the Program, or with the time I am involved in the Program, including, particularly, such risks created by actions, inactions, or negligence on the part of Village Tutors or its directors, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, successors, or assigns, including but not limited to risks created by the following:
 - (a) the use and condition of various premises, facilities, and equipment;
 - (b) the lack or inadequacy of policies, rules, or regulations of the Program;
 - (c) the failure of FFA to foresee or to protect me from actions, inactions, negligence, recklessness, or intentional or criminal misconduct of persons, other than those affiliated with Village Tutors;
 - (d) the inadequacy or unavailability of medical facilities or treatment; or
 - (e) the lack or inadequacy of supervision.
3. Assumption of Risk. I assume all risks, known and unknown, foreseeable and unforeseeable, in any way connected with my participation in the Program. I accept personal responsibility for any liability, injury, loss, or damage in any way connected with my participation in the Program.
4. Release and Waiver. I release Village Tutors and its directors, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, successors, and assigns from any and all liability for and waive any and all claims for injury, loss, or damage, including attorneys' fees, in any way connected with my participation in the Program (a "Claim"), whether or not caused in whole or part by the negligence or other misconduct of Village Tutors or any of the individuals mentioned above.
5. Indemnification. I agree to indemnify and to hold harmless (in other words, to reimburse and to be responsible for) Village Tutors and its directors, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, successors, and assigns from all claims for any liability, injury, loss, damages, or expense, including attorneys' fees (including the cost of defending any Claim I might make, or that might be made on my behalf, that is released or waived by this instrument), in any way connected with or arising out of my participation in the Program, whether or not caused in whole or in part by the negligence or other misconduct of Village Tutors or any of the individuals mentioned above.
6. Binding Effect. This instrument shall be binding upon my relatives, personal representatives, heirs, beneficiaries, next of kin, or assigns and shall inure to the benefit of Village Tutors and its successors and assigns.
7. Consent to Medical Treatment. I authorize Village Tutors to provide to me, through medical personnel of its choice, customary medical assistance, transportation, and emergency medical services. This consent does not impose a duty upon Village Tutors to provide such assistance, transportation, or services.
8. Severability. If any term or provision of this instrument or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall to any extent or for any reason be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of

Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors respects the privacy of every individual who participates in our program by visiting our drop-in center(s), our web sites and the online Virtual Campus. This privacy statement provides notice of our information collection practices and of the ways in which information may be used. What information does Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors collect and how is it used?

A. Personally-Identifiable Information:

Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors typically receives specific data about its volunteer tutors, and student participants and their parent(s)/guardian(s), only when such information is provided voluntarily, such as: providing resume information for employment opportunities, or completing a Volunteer Tutor application; providing school enrollment, class and/or instructor lists, curriculum, or Student Registration application; requesting information by mail, telephone, facsimile, or electronic mail; or sending electronic mail to Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors. Personally-identifiable information provided to Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors is used to fulfill only specific request(s) of the provider and to satisfy reporting requirements set forth by the Internal Revenue Service and the State of Washington. Additionally, Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors collects student school performance information, including grades. This information is used to generate aggregated, generalized reports of the program's performance for the public. Absent any instruction from person(s) concerned, Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors reserves the right, in its discretion, to use information provided to send bulletins and other important information about services offered through its program, its authorized agents, and/or other goods and services offered by third-party providers with whom Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors has relationships and whose offerings may be of interest to the recipient. Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors WILL NOT, however, sell or trade personally-identifiable information unless authorized or legally required to do so, or in the case of imminent physical harm to the person or other parties.

B. Non Personally-Identifiable (Generic) Information:

Generic information does NOT reveal the identity of any individual. Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors receives some generic information automatically, such as when a person visits one of its web sites. In such case, the information received usually includes information about the Internet address assigned to the computer used by the visitor accessing its web sites, the number and frequency of visitors and visits, and the sites and pages visited. This information is used for the limited purpose of determining service improvements and ongoing web site development needs. This process may be enhanced by using certain technologies, including "cookies" (a technology that can be used to provide the visitor with tailored information about Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors services and a personalized experience while visiting its web sites), when permitted by the browser settings selected by the visitor and in force during the site session. Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors also receives some generic information, including demographic information, voluntarily from program participants such as when completing a Demographic Questionnaire. This information is used for the limited purpose of reporting on program diversity to sponsoring agencies and governmental entities. Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors does not combine generic information with any personally-identifiable information.

C. Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors Virtual Campus:

Information that you disclose in a public space, including on any bulletin board, chat room, or web site Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors may host as part of its services, is available to anyone and everyone who visits that space. Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors cannot safeguard any information disclosed in these locations by participants. Additionally, Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors web sites may contain links to sites that belong to third parties unrelated to Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors. Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors cannot protect any information disclosed in these sites by program participants, and recommends participants review the privacy policy statements of those third-party sites.

D. Exceptions and Limitations:

Notwithstanding the foregoing and in compliance with applicable laws, Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors (i) cooperates fully with state, local, and federal officials in any investigation relating to any content (including personal or private electronic communications transmitted to Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors) or purported unlawful activities of any user of its services, and (ii) takes reasonable measures to protect its proprietary rights. For the limited purposes of accomplishing such cooperation and measures and in compliance with applicable laws, Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors may be required to disclose personally identifiable information. In addition, Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors may elect to monitor the areas of communication of any kind (i) to satisfy any law, regulation, or government request; (ii) if such disclosure is necessary or appropriate to operate Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors service; or (iii) to protect the rights or property of Enumclaw + Black Diamond Tutors or others.
